Promote Fairtrade in the school and wider community, by taking part in Fairtrade Fortnight, completing Fairtrade Challenges and highlighting Fairtrade activities in newsletters and on Seesaw.

- Use Fairtrade products around the school wherever possible, e.g.: in the staffroom, at meetings and events we run in school or in the community

- Explore using uniforms made with Fairtrade cotton
- Use the Fairtrade Schools Award identities on the website, Seesaw, Twitter, newsletter etc.
- Put this Policy into practice through a Fairtrade/Eco-Committee that meets regularly to: monitor and drive forward the school's support for Fairtrade
 - make sure those connected with our school are aware of this Policy and can support it
- take responsibility for Fairtrade Challenges and the Fairtrade Action Plan
